1. What special day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?
2. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?

What was the name of the man in this reading who is both a king and a priest?

3. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial?

What is the theme of this Psalm?

Who is mentioned in both the first reading and the Responsorial?

This man is unique. Not only is he both a king and a priest (like Jesus), he also has no genealogy mentioned in the Bible; no mother or father, no mention of where he was born or when he died. He is called a priest "forever," just like Jesus.

4. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?

What does this reading describe?

5. Did you receive Holy Communion, today?

Do you really believe that Jesus is present in the Holy Eucharist?

When you walk up to receive Holy Communion, you should be very reverent. You should be quiet, focused on the Eucharist you are about to receive, and very clear when you receive the Precious Body and say, "Amen." If you receive in your hands, make sure you carefully step to the side, face the altar, and place the Precious Body into your mouth.

What should you do *after* you receive the Holy Eucharist?
